The exhibition will display 68 works by Van Gogh, illustrating the efforts made by early promoters of his art in America. The DIA was the first public museum in the United States to purchase a painting by Van Gogh in 1922, his *Self-Portrait* (1887).

Visiting Breugel's *The Wedding Dance*, which is the subject of our March Art League lecture, as well as the Frida Kahlo exhibit is also on the agenda for the day.
